



Pendleside Hospice



For those newly diagnosed or already living with cancer and other life limiting illnesses, Pendleside Hospice can offer real support to patients and their families and carers.

Providing care to anyone over the age of 18, Pendleside's nursing staff work alongside other healthcare professionals to offer specialist care tailored to the needs of individuals. Services are provided in patients' homes, at the Hospice in our day therapy and inpatient units or on an outpatient basis.

Qualified staff are on hand to answer questions and to offer support to those receiving treatment. We have complementary therapists trained to offer massage, reflexology and aromatherapy. Macmillan Physiotherapists based at Pendleside offer treatment for a range of

symptoms including mobility problems, pain and fatigue.

Our inpatient facility has 10 individual, en-suite bedrooms overlooking beautiful gardens, abundant with seasonal plants and flowers and visits from local wildlife.

Patients can access short-term inpatient care for symptom control, rehabilitation and crisis respite. Our aim is to promote the quality of life for each individual and their family and carers. The Hospice is also a place where people can choose to spend the last days of their life if being at home is not an option.

Family and carers, who are so often overlooked when caring for a close friend or relative, can seek support and advice from our Family Support Co-ordinator, support groups and one-to-one counselling.

As well as our employed staff, Pendleside relies heavily on support from volunteers. Local people give generously of their time, many of them sharing experiences with the people they seek to support. Amongst other duties, they provide assistance at meal times, greet visitors on reception and arrange flowers.

Volunteers are also vital in helping to raise funds to continue the work of the Hospice, either by helping in one of our 7 Hospice shops, being part of a fundraising group, holding an event, or as a lottery collector.

Current statistics suggest that 1 in 3 of us may experience cancer at some time in our lives. Our aim at Pendleside is to help people manage the symptoms of their illness, enabling them to live their life in comfort and dignity.

Without your help we wouldn't be able to continue to provide the care relied upon by so many in our community.

Hospices are about people helping people. You may never know them, or their families, but ultimately you will know that it was you who cared enough to help.
